APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY:

- Eagle Scout residing in the Cascade Pacific Council service area.
- Current high school senior with minimum 3.0 grade point average (*Current cumulative GPA*) or 2025 high school graduate who earned Eagle rank after January 2025 and did not previously apply for CPC scholarships.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION CRITERIA:

- Application: Fully completed, typed application form. [Download the REQUIRED fillable form](#)
- Essay: One page, typed essay discussing how Scouting has influenced your life and developed your character.
- Copy of “**Eagle Scout Service Project REPORT Pages A-C**” from Eagle Scout Service Project Workbook
- Demonstrated leadership.
