“Scout Master Cook-off”

Rules



Contestants:

Five Judges, along with a Tie-Breaker only Judge, have been pre-selected based on their palates, degree of culinary understanding, ability to resist Sith mind probes, and Midi-Chlorian counts at time of selection. They have been vetted, approved, and sanctioned by the Jedi Council, the 2022 Timberline Camporee Planning Committee, and the Galactic Senate. These Judges will remain anonymous for fear of dire repercussions from the Empire should their identities ever be discovered.

Details:

Scoutmasters can earn points toward Top Unit by participating in this event. The top winner will be honored with a special award that they can display for the following year. Due to fire regulations you will have to use a propane stove.

Contest Rules:

- Contestants will provide all ingredients in a clear listing.
- A copy of recipe and cooking method will be provided to aid in judging. This may be in basic terms
 - Ex. “The dough was cooked in vegetable oil.” OR “The vegetable oil was warmed to 375 degrees, and the dough was spooned into the oil for 5 min. and 30 sec per side. When the internal temperature reached 190 degrees the dough was removed with steel tongs and allowed to rest for 93 seconds.”)
- Meals will be fully prepared and cooked on-site at camporee.
 - Only minor pre-prepping before arrival is expected. (Use the Force and The Scout Oath and Law to guide you in this.) [You may also approach Eric Gorger at HQ or Yoda on Dagobah, if guidance you seek.]
- Start time for Scoutmaster Cook-off is 3:00 p.m. and entries must be submitted to judge’s table at Camporee Headquarters no later than 6:30 p.m.
- Each contestant will be assigned a number when they register at check-in to prevent judging bias.
- The contestant will deliver no less than one plate tagged with their assigned number.
- A full meal for each judge is not expected but there will be 5-6 judges in the process and each must have a reasonable sample to try. More is allowed, but not required.
- Contestants will be judged on flavor, texture, and presentation.
- Judges will rate each category 1-10 and score will be total.
- In the event of a tie, the tie will be broken by the “Tie Fighter” Judge, who will be recused from all voting unless a tie must be broken.
- All decisions of the judges are final and may not be appealed or contested. Doing so may cause a disturbance in the force and alert the Sith Lords of the Old Republic to our presence, with unfathomable consequences.
